Contra Costa County Public Works Ranks 51 on Top 100 Fleets in America

May 14, 2019, Martinez, CA – Contra Costa County Public Works is ranked at #51 in the 100 Best Fleets Program out of 38,000 public fleets across the nation.

This is the third year in a row that our Fleet Services has made the list, including coming in at #63 last year. The program recognizes and rewards peak performing fleet operations in North America. Currently in its sixteenth year, 100 Best Fleets annually reviews and identifies performance improvement within the fleet industry.

Contra Costa County Fleet Services is responsible for the maintenance and repair of county vehicles, including Sherriff patrol and green alternative-fueled vehicles, and equipment. Our Fleet Services has an inventory of nearly 1600 light and heavy equipment, vehicles and buses. Fleet Services is a facility equipped with solar power and is a Green Business Program participant.
